Get Started Using W3HUB E-Mail Account With Your iPhone

1. On your iPhone home screen tap the settings icon
2. Tap on Mail, Contacts, Calendars
3. Tap on Add Account
4. Tap on Other
5. Enter this information:
6. Your Name: Enter your name as you would like it to appear in the "From" field of your outgoing messages.
7. Email Address: Enter your full mail address (e.g., [john@yourdomain.com](#)).
8. Password: Enter your e-mail account password.
9. Description: Enter in a description of this account
10. Tap Save
11. Tap POP tab
12. Tap Incoming Mail Server
13. Incoming mail server (POP3): type "mail." followed by your domain name (e.g. mail.yourdomain.com)
14. User Name: Enter your full email address
15. Password: Enter your e-mail account password
16. Scroll down and enter this information
17. Outgoing mail server (SMTP): type "mail." followed by your domain name (e.g. mail.yourdomain.com)
18. User Name: Enter your full email address
19. Password: Enter your password
20. Tap Save
21. If a screen comes up that says "Do you want to try setting up the account without SSL?" Tap Yes
22. Tap Save
23. Tap Save

At this point, your email account is configured and ready to use on your iPhone.

If you are getting error messages / unable to sent e-mails via your iPhone, check the following settings:

- 24.Â Â Tap on your email account
- 25.Â Â Tap on SMTP
- 26.Â Â Tap on the Primary Server box
- 27.Â Â Tap on the button with the Use SSL to turn it off, Tap on the server port and Change your outgoing server setting to 25
- 28.Â Â Tap the SMTP tab in the upper left to go back
- 29.Â Â Tap the name you have given the account tab in the upper left to go back
- 30.Â Â Tap the advanced box
- 31.Â Â Tap on the button with the Use SSL to turn it off
- 32.Â Â Make sure the Server Port is 110, if not please enter it
- 33.Â Â Tap the name you have given the account tab in the upper left to go back
- 34.Â Â Tap the mail tab in the upper left corner to go back to you mail settings
- 35.Â Â Push the home button to finish
